Taste of Hudson Sept. 3-4, 2017

Hudson's premiere outdoor culinary entertainment festival is now in its 11th year! Held over Labor Day weekend, the festival spans three downtown greens and features fabulous food from Hudson area eateries, an outdoor beer & wine garden, live entertainment on three stages, cooking demos, artisans, children's activities, and much more. Case Barlow Farm hosts an event that is part history, part pure family fun.

This historic farm was owned by descendants of pioneers Chauncey and Cleopatra Case. It dates to 1831, when the Cases used bricks fired on their property to build the current house across the street from their original cabin.

The farm continued in the same family until 1996 when it was donated to the First Congregational Church, then purchased by the Case Barlow non-profit to avoid its development.

The Fall Festival honors that heritage, while adding a huge dose of family fun!



Fall Fest at Case Barlow Farm September 10, 2017

Family friendly activities include a rope maze, wagon train rides, crafts and demonstrations, hayrides and pony rides, candle dipping, making butter and traditional games such as a scavenger hunt, bobbing for apples, sack races, 3-legged race, cookie walk, and horseshoes.
